The Vermillion River meanders through the eastern boundary of the property, providing recreational and hunting potential. An access easement for adjacent properties is located on the west boundary of the property. According to Surety/AgriData, the land has a productivity index of 72.9 and a soil rating of .750. Predominate soils include Egan-Ethan complex, 2-6 percent slopes; Davis loam, 0-2 percent slopes. The FSA office estimates there are approximately 62.49 acres of cropland with a 29.10-acre corn base/137-bushel PLC yield and a 29.10-acre soybean base/39-bushel PLC yield. Taxes: \$1,393.52.


